



**Notification of The Institute for the Promotion of Teaching Science and Technology  
On Intention of Administration with Honesty for Fiscal Year 2023  
“IPST performs its duties with honesty, transparency, and good governance”**

As a government agency that values the prevention and suppression of corruption, The Institute for the Promotion of Teaching Science and Technology (IPST) performs its duties with honesty, transparency, and good governance by following the principles of Corporate Governance and encouraging its executives and personnel to perform their duties with morality. IPST executives and personnel shall not be involved in conflict of interest and exploit power of their positions for any person's advantage; they stand against any forms of corruption in order to gain trust from all groups of stakeholders of IPST and to promote sustainable corporate development.

IPST hereby notifies its intention to perform the duties with honesty to its executives and personnel to adhere with the following principles.

1. **Performance of duties:** considering honesty, transparency, fairness, adherence to morals and ethics, conscience, full responsibility and common interest; complying with the laws, regulations, orders and rules
2. **Use of budget:** adhering to worthiness, appropriateness, objectives, transparency; not benefiting oneself or others
3. **Use of power:** being fair and non-discriminatory; not exploiting power for any person's benefits and influencing the corruption in the performance of others
4. **Use of property:** not taking property of IPST for oneself or others and seeking benefits from IPST's name, logo, or other properties
5. **Disclosure:** providing clear information to clients, visitors or stakeholders; not hiding or distorting information and exploiting confidential or non-disclosure information from the duties for the benefit of oneself or others
6. **Corruption Prevention:** not being involved in any forms of corruption and misconduct and ignoring any actions that are considered corruption or misconduct; cooperating in providing information or investigating facts
